## **DISCUSSION**

<u>North Longvard Road</u> Chairman Hansen stated information about 206 acres of land owned by the Griffin Land Trust that was to be the site of Carvana. The soils are too dense to farm. As of this meeting, there has been no documentation of a Right of First Refusal from the Select Board office on the property.

<u>Master Plan Committee</u> Chairman Hansen nominated Vice Chairman Maryssa Cook-Obregon as a member of the Master Plan Committee. Chairman Hansen will contact Chairman Pratt of the Conservation Commission as Maryssa Cook-Obregon is also a member of that commission. Commissioner Colson seconded the motion. The roll call vote was as follows:

Community Garden Chairman Hansen stated that the garden has since been overgrown. Commissioner Cecchini will do the tilling in early November. Art Pinell DBA Westview Farms has been contracted to do the perimeter mowing. The funding will be provided by the Conservation Commission maintenance line item.

<u>Right to Farm</u> Chairman Hansen noted that the signs have been placed by the DPW. The locations are to the borders of the Town.

<u>Lombella Property – Tannery Road</u> Chairman Hansen related that attempts have been made to have the property owners preserve the land. The 80 acre parcel could produce as many as 25 residential dwelling and has close access to the rail trail. The property was discussed at a Planning Board meeting to possibly change the zoning for the parcel from Industrial Restricted. Chairman Hansen will contact Mr. Goddard for more information.

85 College Highway & 22 Nicholson Hill Road Chairman Hansen noted that the property at 85 College Highway, 2 acres with an existing barn, is being sold separately from the 18.9 actress to the rear on Nicholson Hill Road. The property owner is Michael Burns.

<u>Granby Open Farm Day</u> Granby will host it's Farm Day on the 18<sup>th</sup>. Commissioner Ciak-Bissaillon stated that each farm has a booth to highlight the products they sell or produce.

<u>45 Coes Hill Road</u> Ms. Cindy Marshall, 45 Coes Hill Road, requested information on the budget amount the Agricultural Commission has for purchasing potential APR property. The Commission does not have any funding to purchase land, but encourages property owners of large tracks of land to consider preservation.

**Budget** The FY 22 budget remains at \$950.00.
