MINUTES

Mrs. Nilsson made a motion to accept the minutes of June 7, 2018. Ms. Brzoska seconded the motion. The vote of the Board was unanimous in favor.

MR. FITZGERALD'S REPORT

The Board of Health members discussed the current office support. The position is budgeted through the Building Department. The Board members will do research on the history and the current job description for the office secretarial support. A meeting may be scheduled with the Select Board once the data is reviewed.

87 Klaus Anderson Road A court date has been scheduled with the receiver for this property.

<u>18 Eagle Street</u> Mr. FitzGerald along with Building Inspector Art Lawler have completed their final inspections and signed off on the property.

<u>54 Davis Road</u> Mr. FitzGerald contacted the owner of record (bank) regarding the condition of the property after receiving a complaint. The bank declared that the property was properly boarded up and secure and the pool was removed. Mr. FitzGerald reinspected the property and sent photos to the bank documenting that the house is not properly secured and the pool is still present.

<u>176 College Highway</u> Mr. FitzGerald received a complaint from a neighbor with concerns that the owner of record is digging in the area of their septic system. Mr. FitzGerald spoke with one of the owners that stated they are having issues with their septic system but have not made any changes. Mr. FitzGerald informed the property owner of the proper steps to take in regards to septic system issues and requested that they get back to him in a week regarding their intent.

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<u>440 College Highway</u> Mr. FitzGerald has not heard back from the Fire Inspector regarding the possible fire code Violations within the 2nd floor apartment. The Building Inspector has stated that the 2nd floor apartment does not require a second means of egress. Mr. FitzGerald and the Board of Health are concerned because the only means of egress is next to the stove. Mr. FitzGerald will reinspect the property before bringing the issue to Housing Court. If the violations are not corrected.

<u>94 Vining Hill Road</u> Mr. FitzGerald received a complaint regarding junk on the property. Mr. FitzGerald inspected the property with Mr. Dennis Clark due to the presence of wetlands. The residents were in the process of moving. The neighbor dismissed the complaint.
