CODE UPDATES

Ms. Spencer and the Board discussed various updates that need to be made to the Board of Health Codes/Regulations as well as some updates to the Board of Health’s portion of the Town’s website. Ms. Spencer is currently working with MHOA Lawyers on the Tobacco Regulations, and updating the permanent makeup portion of the Body Art Regulations. South Pond Beach testing began on June 17, 2021.

The Public Health Excellence Grant Program for Shared Services re-opened. Ms. Spencer spoke with representative from Granville, Tolland, and Blandford about the grant.

COVID-19 DISCUSSION

Southwick has had 4 positive cases and 307 tests in the last 14 days. There have been more calls from local businesses regarding employee's potential exposure to COVID-19.

Curative held a COVID-19 clinic at Southwick Regional High School. Approximately 53 people were vaccinated. A second dose clinic will be held on Tuesday, July 6, 2021.

Vaxmillions will begin on July 1, 2021. Fully vaccinated Massachusetts residence 12 years and older will be eligible to win 1 of 5 \$1 million prizes.
