- Policy Review: Hot Spot -

One family is checking the 'hot spot' out all the time. The current checkout period is one week. Lynn suggests changing the policy to one time/month for 1 week per person.

Motion made by Carol; seconded by Maria, to accept Lynn's suggestion.

- Out of Town Residents -

Granby, CT library charges our patrons \$30.00/year to use its library, and we do the same to them now. (This is the only town in CT that we charge.) Motion to drop this charge made by Suzanne; seconded by Tammy. Unanimously approved.

- General Instagram Account - Discussion ensued.

This must go before the Select Board for approval.

- Friends' Picnic Table Project The tables made in prison that Diane was investigating were found to be more expensive than other sources. Lynn has found another source that may charge \$500-\$800 for a table. She will talk with Bob Johnson for advice and more information. It was suggested that she check into the Westfield Technical Academy to see if it could be a source for the table and get pricing.
- Hoopla Digital for Libraries -

Circulate digital movies and music. Can be borrowed for 1 week at a time. Deposit is \$1000.00 which is spent down over a 3-month period. Then pay so much /month spending on usage. Funds could come from the Library 'gift account'. Lynn will look further into this to get more information and will likely set this up for a 'trial subscription'.
