

In FY2022, the town approved an additional staff member at a part-time level for the TCC office. The added position was for the FY22 change in tax collections and the overall need for the demands in the office.

Southwick is the LAST town to still hold a Treasurer/Collector/Clerk combination. With new election law changes, change in tax collections, and covid changes the staff is overwhelmed.

On June 22, 2022, "The Votes Act" was signed into law making new and temporary election processes permanent. These changes included but not limited to;

- 1. Primary Elections now have early voting along with State election
- 2. Local elections now will have early voting unless opt out
- 3. Last day to register to vote is on a Saturday.
- 4. Early voting is mandatory on the weekends.
- 5. Vote by mail is permanent and has several processing components and is time consuming!!!!

See chart for the mail in ballot process only. So for example, using the November 2020 State election and only the mail in ballots of 1800;

Average 7 mins for full ballot process x 1800 ballots / 60 mins = 210 hours just to process mailed in ballots

Jessica and I endured the 2020 changes by working **extra** long hours. There is so much involved in every election process. With the new and now permanent changes, the TCC office can NOT continue without additional help. When elections are upon us, Jessica and I are the primary for the election but we are also pulled to assist in all other functions to include but not limited to the phones and counter. The current staffing levels are struggling with these demands, so I am requesting either a full time employee or add another part-time so combined with the current part-time, it equals the full time.
