# **DISCUSSION**

West Springfield Covid test kits – Mr. Hibert said that Covid tests have been made available for free through the state so he ordered 1,000 tests, with 5 tests per pack. He made up a sign to put out at Town Hall stating one box per family and distributed them to the library.

Revision of Fee Schedule – Mr. Hibert said he is looking into changing the pricing for the fees as some towns set them by the risk, seats or square footage. He also wants to add frozen dessert applications back into the schedule.

Renewal Application Letters – Mr. Hibert added some information to clarify the difference between a food service, catering and retail permit on the application.

# **Disposal Septic System:**

- 1 Tall Pines Trail A new plan was approved. A final inspection was conducted and a COC was issued.
- 5 Tall Pines Trail A new plan was approved. A final inspection was conducted and a COC was issued.
- 40 Woodside Circle A plan was approved for a repair and a final inspection was done.
- 61 Hastings Road A plan was approved for a repair and a perc.
- 59 College Highway The plan was approved for a repair and inspection. It is an ongoing install as the lot is very tight.
- -110 Summer Avenue A plan was approved for a repair and a perc.
- -173 College Highway A plan was approved for a repair and a perc.
- 5 Pine Knoll A plan was approved for a repair and a perc.

# **Housing Inspection:**

- 108 Point Grove Road Mr. Hibert said the tenant is moving out and he will issue the landlord a no rental agreement until an inspection passes.
- 80 Bungalow Street Mr. Hibert said the water has been shut off and when he went to inspect the house he found other issues; heater leaking, trash outside and mold in the basement. He has to go back to re-inspect in 30 days.
- 33 Granville Road Mr. Hibert said the water has been shut off and the home appears vacant.

# **Food Service Inspection:**

- Dunkin Donuts 397 College Highway Mr. Hibert said he received a complaint from a customer about buying a drink that had a chemical taste and later not feeling well. He inspected the machine that had been cleaned the night before. He sent information to the customer about the cleaning tablets and spoke to the manager. Mr. Hibert cited them for some cleanliness items and told them they need to always have a Serve Safe person on staff.
- Inspection Software Mr. Hibert said the software is coming through via the PHE grant. He signed a software agreement and sent the company a spreadsheet with all of our issued permits. The other towns in the agreement also need to do this. Once they do, it should be up and running.

#### Other:

- WHCPHD Grant Mr. Hibert said he had received one application for the nursing position.
- Totally Title 5 Seminar Mr. Hibert attended the seminar that covered septic systems and earned some Continuing Education Unit's.
