Mr. Phillips spoke to Danny Oleksak about surveying and he stated that he's 'all set to go'. He will start soon and will submit an invoice for the surveying work.

Mr. Phillips discussed with Gene Theroux about the placement of water containers so the Commission can notify the Fire Department to fill them up.

The Commission discussed with Mr. Phillips about contacting Gene Theroux to set up date(s) and time(s) to have civic organizations come to help clean the grave stones.

Mr. Phillips talked with the Warren Baker about planting trees and what kind of trees are good for the cemetery.

The Commission discussed having the fence and the cameras installed in the cemetery. Ms. St. Sauveur will contact Paul Allen at Protective Security Services to see if he can attend the July meeting to discuss the details.

The Commission discussed whether the roads would be able to get repaved and also if there would be tree work done in the old cemetery. Do we go thru CPC or thru Mr. Stinehart?

Ms. St. Sauveur mentioned that we had received a phone call about the Boy Scouts wanting to do a service project and use a GPS to survey the graves.

Next meeting is scheduled for July 23, 2019 at 5:30p.m.




