Town of Southwick Senior Citizen Tax Work-Off Program

Earn up to \$1500.00 off your tax bill by working 105 hours in a Town Department or school environment must qualify to participate All interested applicants can request a packet by coming to the Senior Center beginning on Tuesday May 16th. Appointments with Cindy must be scheduled on May 30th or 31st to go over applications. Applications MUST be completed when you come for this appointment. These dates are strictly enforced. There will be (10) available positions on a lottery basis. There will be a lottery if there are more than 10 eligible applicants on June 9th. Applicants are eligible for one year unless there are positions that remain open. Placements can begin as early as July 1st depending on the Department. The qualifications for the program can also be found on our website at www.southwickma.org/
