BROWN BAG DISTRIBUTION



Garlic Parmesan Pork Cutlet, serves 4

4 boneless pork chops approximately 3-4 ounces each

salt and pepper to taste

1½ tablespoons salted butter

3 cloves garlic minced

1½ cup heavy cream

2 tablespoons all purpose flour

3/4 cup grated parmesan

1 tablespoon minced fresh parsley

Instructions

Heat a large skillet over medium heat. Add butter and allow to melt, stirring to coat the pan.

Sprinkle each pork chop with salt and pepper to taste on both sides.

Add pork to skillet and cook each side for 4-5 minutes or until both sides are golden brown. Turn off heat and cover with a tight lid. Let the chops sit for 8-10 minutes until fully cooked through. Set aside on a foil tented plate to keep warm.

Scrape the pan to release all that yumminess, no need to clean the pan.

Heat pan to medium high heat. Toss garlic in the pan and allow to caramelize for 1-2 minutes until fragrant. Add in the flour and cream and stir quickly to combine. Bring to a boil, and then reduce to a simmer. Allow to simmer for 2 minutes.

Stir in the grated parmesan and fresh parsley, stirring until fully combined and heated through. Return pork to the sauce, simmer briefly and serve.

This can be served with potatoes, rice or pasta with your favorite vegetable

The BIG E Vaccination site has opened. Every age group is now eligible for the vaccination. The link to the site is:

Please have your health insurance card available to help registration go smoothly. If you need a ride to any vaccination site please call us and we can schedule you a ride. You can find out more details about all of the vaccines available at https://www.mass.gov/covid-19-vaccine or by calling your health care provider. In Mid-May 65% of Southwick residents over 75 and 61% of Southwick residents between the ages of 65-74 have received the vaccine. Select Board Member Mr. Moglin, Mr. Fox, and Mr. Deedy, and Mr. Stinehart received their vaccine and are now fully vaccinated. The COA staff have also received their vaccines. Let's all work together to get rid of this virus. Please continue to wash your hands, socially distance, and wear a mask where required.
