The SHINE Program provides free health insurance information and counseling to all Massachusetts residents with Medicare and their caregivers. People who have Medicare or who are about to become eligible for Medicare can meet with a counselor to learn about bene-Serving the Health fits and options available. A counselor will review programs that help people with limited income to pay health care costs. You must call to schedule an appointment.

COMPANION PROGRAM

The Southwick Senior Center has created a Companion Program. The program will assist frail, homebound adults aged 60 and older. Program services will include transportation to medical appointments for a small fee, grocery shopping assistance, errands, and companionship. These services are provided to recipients by dedicated volunteers who receive reimbursement for their gas mileage. The reward for the companion volunteer is knowing that you are making a difference in the life of a Senior Citizen who needs assistance. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer or if you feel you may quality to be a client in this program please call the Senior Center. There will be required training for the volunteer and a criminal background check will be completed. Companions do not have to be Seniors. Please call the Senior Center to sign up.
