

<u>Blood Pressure screenings</u>: The Fire Dept. will be doing a blood pressure screenings It will be held every Monday from 11:00am-12:00pm. This screening should not take the place of your regular doctor visit. This is a drop in screening so no appointments are necessary.



<u>Foot Care Clinics</u> will be held at the Southwick Senior Center by our new Foot Nurse Debra J. Deane, RN,BSN. The cost of this service is \$40.00 paid directly to the nurse. Appointments will be held every month. We are currently schedul-

ing appointments for March 21st. You must call the Senior Center and schedule an appointment.



The SHINE Program provides free health insurance information and counseling to all Massachusetts residents with Medicare and their caregivers. People who have Medicare or who are about to become eligible for Medicare can meet with a counselor to learn about benefits and options available. A counselor will review programs that help people with limited income to pay health care costs. You must call to schedule an appointment.
