

FRTA INFO:

The Franklin Transit Authority will be increasing their fees beginning on July 1st. Fares will be increased by .25 cents per ride. Town trips will now be \$1.25, out of town trips will be \$1.75 and beyond adjacent town trips will be \$2.25. Trips to the Senior Center will be .75cents . There has not been an increase in fares since 2009. This is not a Town of Southwick or a Senior Center decision. These fares are collected by the FRTA and given directly to the FRTA. Town of Southwick Senior Citizen Tax Work-Off Program

dining room. Space is limited so sign up soon!!!


Memorial Day Breakfast
