manent MEDRETURN drop location has been established.

It's that time of year again! If you have a Medicare Prescription Drug Plan or a Medicare Advantage Plan (HMO or PPO), you should receive a notice from your plan by the end of September. During Medicare Open Enrollment, from October 15th to December 7th, you will be able to change your plan for next year. Andrea will be setting up appointments for every Tuesday & Thursday through open enrollment season. Call the center to set up an appointment 569-5498.

IMPORTANT: New this year is that everyone will need a MyMedicare account. Please set up that account before you come in for your SHINE appointments. Go to MyMedicare.gov and follow the directions on the screen. We have computers here at the Senior Center. A staff person will be able to assist you on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 2:00pm-3:30pm. You must also remember to bring all documents to your appointment. If you do not have the correct information we will have to re-schedule your appointment for another day.
