Cindy has been training on how to put together new format for our Newsletter. Junes issue will have a new look, going out in end of May.

Classes canceled until fall. Chi-Gong, Chair Yoga and Zumba will be on Channel 15.

Hands free hand sanitizers are ordered for senior areas. Bought new smaller washable couch for center, got rid of old fabric green couch.

Cindy, volunteers and some staff are picking up prescriptions and groceries for some people. Staff is doing wellness check by phone calls.

Theresa left meeting at 12:57pm.

Brown bag – Food bank prepares and delivers to center. Cindy will hand out.

Center is closed, open only to staff.

Cindy is trying to come up with ideas to use up grant money.

Transportation – will begin slowly on May 11th. One rider at a time, wearing face mask. Exact money going in box in van, driver (Ken) wears a mask as well. Rides are only for Doctors visits, no sick visits.
