Update from COA director:

Update on programs:

Dining rooms - grab and go lunches, about 20-25 participants and about 30 Meals on Wheel deliveries. Mike retired after 15 years of delivering meals. He received a gift card toTuckers from the COA staff and COA board; Harvey Hollm is the lead driver. Three new people have been hired to drive, Bob Stevens, Mary Kibby, and Phyllis Wheeler. Judy Asselin and Maryanne Philo have volunteered to deliver on Thursdays together.

We have 2 drivers per day delivering.

Transportation – FRTA van is still being used with 2 people per ride, wearing masks and socially distanced. Cindy will be using the volunteer van to drive some seniors around to get them out of the house; many have not really been out and are lonely. Claire is her first person; going to Bernie's to pick up her lunch and enjoying the chance to get out.

Finances - are in good shape, looking for more donations for bingo prizes. Budget is coming soon. The formula grant increased to \$12 per person from \$10.

Classes - starting in February, Chi-Gong, Line Dancing, Chair Yoga and Yoga will be on Zoom and live streamed on Channel 15. Money left for classes, so instructors will be paid to come into center and film the class. Donations for the classes will be accepted. At the end of March beginning of April hopefully the tents will be put back up to continue classes. Zumba is still being held outside at Whally Park with Rebecca.

Taxes - Mid-February tax preparation will start. It will be done by drop off, and people will be called the same day to pick up taxes when they are done.
