Town of Southwick Board of Health and Select Board COVID-19 Update for January 8, 2021

As of the most recent weekly public health report, there have been 310 positive cases of COVID-19 in the Town of Southwick. The Southwick Board of Health would like to stress that this is not a complete profile of the status of COVID-19 in the Town of Southwick. This number reflects those individuals who have received positive test results and *not* those awaiting results, untested symptomatic individuals, and those who might currently be asymptomatic. The Baker Administration announced this Thursday that the Governor's COVID-19 Order # 59 - that went into effect on Saturday, December 26 and was expected to end on January 10 - will be continued until **Sunday**, **January 24**th. As a reminder, this order reduces the allowable occupancy limits from the previous capacity level of 40% to **25**% in multiple sectors. The changes in capacity levels are listed below and also in the table following this update:

- 1. Notably, this capacity limit will now apply to restaurants. Capacity will be set at 25% of pre-COVID seating capacity and distancing between tables and other requirements will remain in place. Indoor and Outdoor seating capacity must be calculated separately (rather than combining them).
- 2. Small spaces (such as personal services) and other spaces without clear occupancy standards may use 5 people / 1000 square feet as an alternative to the 25% occupancy.
- 3. The 25% limit will not apply to manufacturing, laboratories, drive in movie theaters, or construction
- 4. Employees/staff are exempted from the capacity count
- 5. Limits at indoor event venues are being reduced to 10 people.
- 6. Limits at outdoor event venues are being reduced to 25 people.
- 7. Current limits at private residences remain the same (10 indoors and 25 outdoors)
- 8. Limits at movie theaters will be reduced to 25% (no more than 50 people per theater)
- 9. Limits outdoor performance venues will remain 25% (with the max number reduced to 25 from 50).
- 10. Office spaces will be required to reduce capacity to 25%, but there will continue to be allowances for offices with "critical services", such as public safety, public health, and other critical services. There is no approval required for these exemptions.
- 11. K-12 schools continue to be exempted from these capacity limits and will need to follow DESE standards and guidelines.

All visitors and returning residents entering Massachusetts must follow the <u>new travel orders</u>. All travelers arriving to Massachusetts – including Massachusetts residents returning home – are instructed to complete the <u>Massachusetts Travel Form</u> prior to arrival and to self-quarantine for 10 days, <u>except travelers from Hawaii</u>. All persons are instructed not to travel to Massachusetts if they are displaying symptoms of COVID-19. Due to the continued rise in cases of COVID-19 in Massachusetts, residents are urged to continue to follow all public health precautions for reducing the spread of COVID-19: stay home unless absolutely necessary; if you must go out in public, practicing social distancing and proper hygiene etiquette; wear face coverings when inside retail stores and when social distancing cannot be maintained; and if you are experiencing signs of illness - fever, cough, shortness of breath — call your primary care provider for advice.
