John said Johnson Electric found the junction box and he may be able to tie into that to get the parking lot lights working. Johnson Electric will put together a quote to install lights and outlets in the pavilion. The restrooms near the pavilion were vandalized. Kevin Bishop will increase patrols at the park. He suggested posting a sign stating the park is closed at dusk. The police Department suggested a security camera be put at the entrance of the park and displayed at dispatch. John will check with Paul Allen for a quote. Bob Johnson is asking about the location of the septic tanks at the park. Tom Fitzgerald has the plans with the locations of the septic tanks. Bob Johnson is inquiring about replacing the waterless urinal cartridges. John said this year would be a good time to change them. Cara will order the cartridges and ask maintenance to replace them.
