Permit application fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) made payable to Town of Southwick. This fee covers review and inspection costs for DPW personnel only. 2. A Connection Fee made payable to the Town of Southwick. See the Sewer Use Regulations for the formula used to determine the amount of the connection fee. 3. A plan showing details of installation including pipe material, pipe size, oil/water separator equipment (if necessary), tight tank equipment (if necessary), pipe inverts, and the horizontal layout in relation to other features (buildings, roads, utilities, etc.). The Applicant agrees to comply with the following provisions: 1. This permit becomes void 12 months after signature of the DPW Director. 4. A completed Sewer System Hookup Checklist is included on the following pages. Applicant is responsible to secure the necessary sign-off's directly with the applicable Town Departments. 2. The Applicant may need to secure additional approvals from other Town agencies, such as Conservation Commission or Planning Board. 3. If applicable, existing septic tanks must be pumped by a licensed septage hauler. Tanks must then be crushed and filled. 4. All connections must be inspected and approved by various Town officials before the trench is backfilled. The Applicant must notify the various officials a minimum of 48 hours in advance of requesting an inspection. Inspections are only made during normal working hours.
