Litigation Matters and Strategy for Collective Bargaining with Police Union Coalition, Fire Department IAFF and Clerk Union UPSEU, **Executive Session RE: M.G.L. Chap. c. 30A, S21 (2) & (3) Ch. 214, Section 1B and;**

Exception #2: Move to go into Executive Session to conduct collective bargaining sessions, with nonunion personnel and to: not to reconvene in Open Session (Chair Must Declare). RE: Ch. 214, Section 1B
