1. Town Administrator Screening Committee convene meeting in Open Session per MGL Ch, 30A.
2. Any other public business or meeting minutes.
3. Move into Executive Session under MGL Ch. 30A, section 21, subsection 8.

Executive Session:

A MOTION to go into Executive Session Pursuant to M.G.L. Chap. c. 30A, S21 (8) to consider or interview applicants for employment or appointment by a preliminary screening committee if the chair declares that an open meeting will have a detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants; provided, however, that this clause shall not apply to any meeting, including meetings of a preliminary screening committee, to consider and interview applicants who have passed a prior preliminary screening; and **not to reconvene in open session. (Chair must declare).**

Chapter 214, Section 1B, a person shall have a right against unreasonable, substantial, or serious interference with their privacy. The superior court shall have jurisdiction in equity to enforce such right and in connection therewith to award damages; and not to reconvene in open session. (Chair must declare).
