- 2. Introduce panel members and roles they represent
- 3. Election of Committee Chairperson and Vice Chairperson
- 4. Affirm Open Meeting Law requirements under AG Office and Confidentiality of process by all committee members
- 5. All votes roll call
- 6. Introduction of MRI Firm with key personnel who will assist panel in candidate recruitment for Town Administrator (C.A.O.) position
- 7. Discuss process and time frame schedule for search
- 8. Any other business
- 9. If necessary, roll call vote into Executive Session pursuant to MGL Ch.30A S21 (8) To Consider or interview applicants for employment or appointment by a preliminary screening committee if the chair declares that an open meeting will have a detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants; provided, however, that this clause shall not apply to any meeting, including meetings of a preliminary screening committee, to consider and interview applicants who have passed a prior preliminary screening; and whether need to reconvene into open session. Chapter 214, Section 1B, A person shall have a right against unreasonable, substantial, or serious interference with their privacy. The superior court shall have jurisdiction in equity to enforce such right and in connection therewith to award damages.
