### **Executive Session:**

**A MOTION** to go into Executive Session Pursuant to M.G.L. Chap. c. 30A, S21 (8) to consider or interview applicants for employment or appointment by a preliminary screening committee if the chair declares that an open meeting will have a detrimental effect in obtaining qualified applicants; provided, however, that this clause shall not apply to any meeting, including meetings of a preliminary screening committee, to consider and interview applicants who have passed a prior preliminary screening; and **not to reconvene in open session. (Chair must declare).**

**Chapter 214, Section 1B, a person shall have a right against unreasonable, substantial, or serious interference with their privacy. The superior court shall have jurisdiction in equity to enforce such right and in connection therewith to award damages; and not to reconvene in open session. (Chair must declare).**
