I am pleased to support the application for funding "Restoration of Historic Steeple and Belfry at Southwick Congregational Church," as described in the application submitted in August. The Southwick Congregational Church (SCC) is among the oldest and most well-recognized public structures in our Town. Together with our Veterans Memorial, Old Public Library, the Southwick Inn and the Country Colonial store, it gives our downtown its distinctive charm that we all love. The need and justification for this unique historical project is well supported by the application and accompanying photos.

As the chair of the SCC Buildings and Grounds Committee, I would like to offer a few additional pictures. These pictures highlight the architectural beauty of the exterior and the rugged timber frame craftsmanship of this 200 year old building.

Timber frame. Timber framing was generally done with lumber from the surrounding land. The logs were hand-hewn to create a flat face and edges. Timbers were assembled using wood joinery such as mortise and tenon joints, wood pegs and notching. Generally, no nails were used in the structural frame. The structural framing was then covered with wood siding.

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on this vital project.
