Baby Play Group : Stories and songs



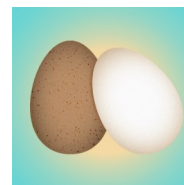
4/11 @10:00am (For ages 0-2 years old.)

Mix It Up Storytime (For ages 2-5)

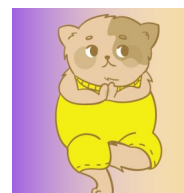
