**Book Club (In Person)-** March 8, 10am- All are welcome to join! March's book is "Redeeming Love" by Francine Rivers.


**Craft and Chat (In Person)** – March 21, 6:30pm– Join us for an evening of crafting and catching up. All are welcome to join.




